							Provide safe and suitable equipment – 110v portable equipment			
							Where power tools used exceed 110v they must be used in conjunction with a RCD			
							All equipment to be checked and PAT tested on a regular basis			
							Keep all trailing leads tidy and not leave trip hazards			
							Unplug equipment when not being used			
							Replace any defective equipment or cables			
Hand arm vibration – damage to fingers, loss of use, broken bones							Do not use over prolonged periods, take short breaks or alternate operators			
							Carry our regular checks on equipment for damage and repair / replace when necessary			
							Do not use equipment outside of manufactures instructions for use			
							Keep hands, warm and dry, exercise fingers regularly
