Burns, Fires, explosions, possible death, skin irritation							Keep fuel stored in plastic or steel containers designed for the purpose and in a secured in a suitably designed place when not in use			
							Filling of vehicles should be done in a well ventilated area			
							Take all reasonable precautions to prevent a fire occurring – do not keep near a heat source			
							Prevent leakage of vapours or liquids			
							All containers to have hazard signs displayed			
							Mobile bowsers should be fitted with locks on hoses, pumps etc and secured safely when not in use			
							Gloves should be worn when handling fuel containers			
							Spills should be reported and care taken not to get into grates or drains
